Stegothsaurus is part dinosaur, part thesaurus. A **thesaurus** is a book that lists words and their synonyms. A **synonym** is a word that has the same or nearly the same meaning as another word.

Synonyms are useful because:

A synonym can be used to avoid repeating the same word.

We ran to the oasis.
As we ~~ran~~ **raced**
toward the shrubs,
our mouths watered.

A synonym can show that something is more or less extreme than the other word.

After lunch, we
waded in the ~~cold~~
freezing pond.

A synonym can be more specific than the other word.

My brothers and I
~~walked~~ **trudged**
through the desert.

A synonym can be used to create a rhythm or rhyme.

We slept beneath the
starry ~~sky~~ **dome**.
Beside my brothers,
I am home.

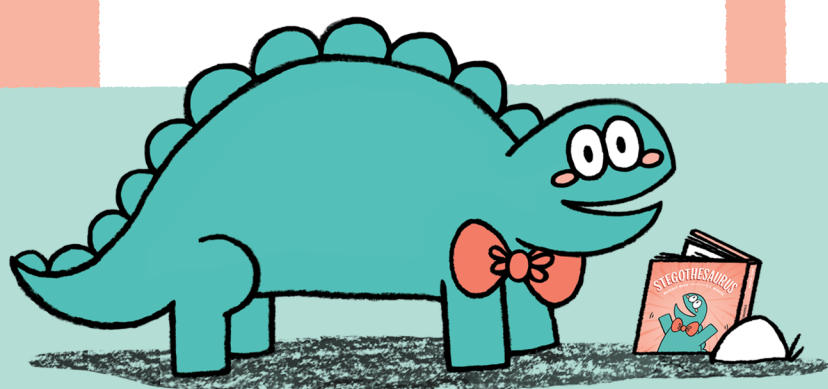
ADVERBS
